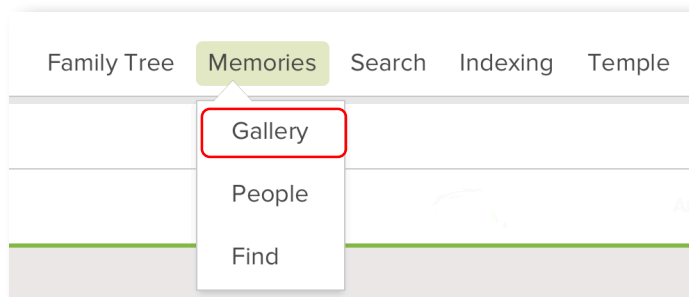


Sharing Photos of Your Ancestors (Living or Deceased) With Your Family Members

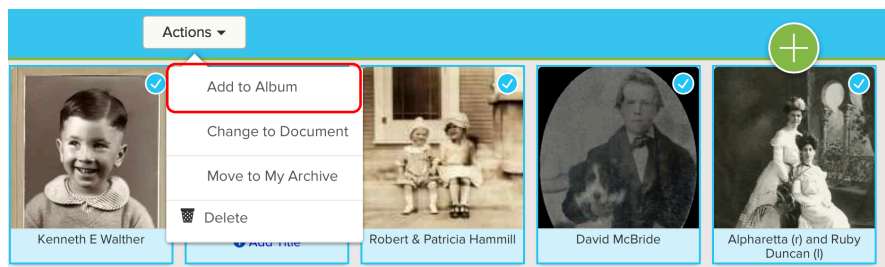
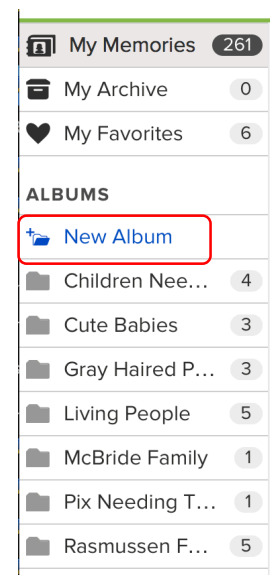
1. Open up Memories - Gallery



2. On the left side, click "new Album" (or use an existing album) and give the Album a name.

3. From the Gallery hover over photos/etc. and a checkmark will appear in right hand corner. Click the checkmark on each photos/documents/etc. you want to add to the Album. (You can move 1 or more at a time and can add to the Album at any time.)

4. Right click on one of the photos you're putting in the Album, click "Add to Album", choose which Album, Click "Add to Album".

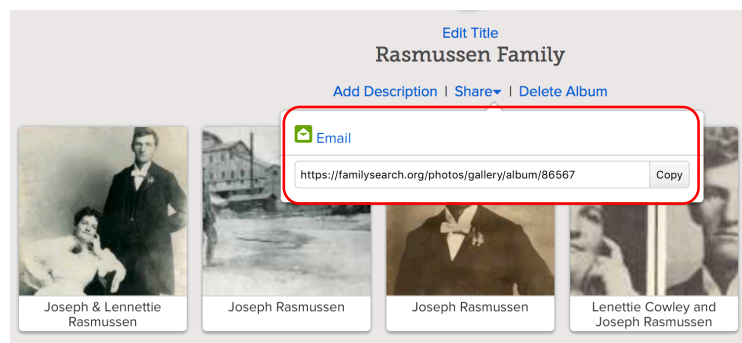


5. Open up the Album you want to share with others.

6. Click on "Share". You now have two options that show up in the little box.

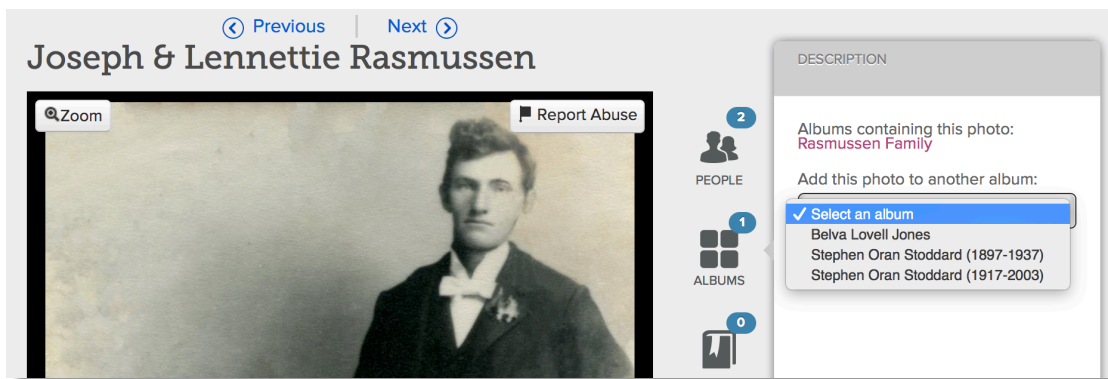
a. You can click on the email icon. Your Email program will open with the link in the body of the text. Enter the email addresses in the Send field. Add a note if needed. Then click send.

b. OR You can click on "Copy" button, go to your email program, right click and paste the link into body of. Add a note to your email if you want. Send the email.

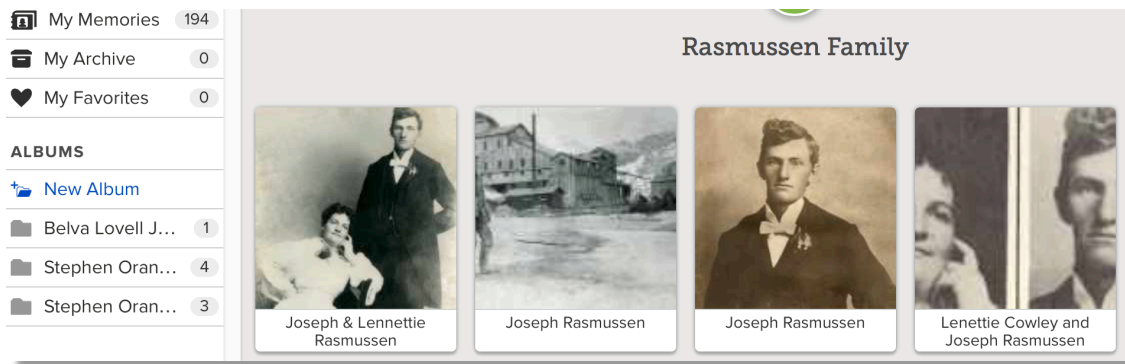


Sharing Photos of Your Ancestors (Living or Deceased) With Your Family Members

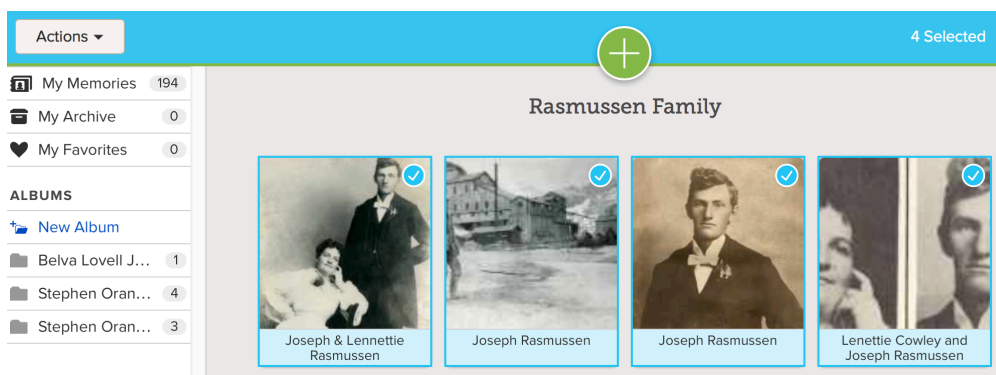
- The Person(s) receiving the email just need to click on the link in their email.
- The FamilySearch page will open with the album that was shared.
- To place them into an album so they may be viewed at any time, click on a photo and the photo page will open up.



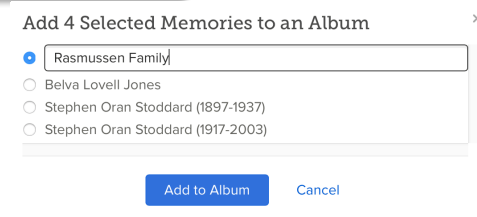
- The album is unlikely to be a part of the person receiving the email link.
- Notice the link called "Rasmussen Family". Click on this link to open up your Gallery.



- Hover over each photo and check the small circle. Click on "Actions" and a menu appears.



- Add a name to this new album, in this case, "Rasmussen Family" and click on the "Add to Album" button.
- That album will now be listed under their list of albums.



Sharing Photos of Your Ancestors (Living or Deceased) With Your Family Members

Tip:

Note that if you have selected 50 photos and added them to your new album, the person that shared the link will get 50 emails from FamilySearch letting them know that [username] just added the photo [name of photo] to an album on FamilySearch. Multiply this times 30 people and suddenly that person could be seeing 1500 emails that they will now have to delete.

It might be better just to save the link somewhere and then open it when you want to view the album.
